A short excerpt from Fr Daniel Mahan’s book: “More than Silver and Gold Homilies from a Stewardship Priest”

“Theses are the questions a good steward must ask on a regular basis.

Stewardship is about our response to God’s invitation. Stewardship is **an attitude**, a stance in life of expressing through our daily living out gratitude to the Lord for all of His blessings. Stewardship is a **way of life** that calls us to ongoing conversion of heart and practical, concrete changes in our lives. Stewardship is what **we do** after we say “We Believe”.

Let’s be clear: stewardship is not about what we do with a portion of our time, talent, or treasure. It is **not** just about the portion we give to the Church. Rather, **stewardship is about how we live out lives in total!**

The key question is **not**, “how much time do I give to God?” **but instead**, “from how much of my time do I exclude God?”

The key question is **not**, “how much am I putting into the collection basket?” **but instead**, how am I using, all of the gifts of treasure at our disposal?” It is a matter of knowing the critical difference between what I own and what owns me.” ...
